- To monitor progress, effort and behaviour

My Role as Form Tutor

- To meet and register students each morning
- To deal with any issues as they arise
- To support students generally
- To check students are ready to learn – equipment checks, ensure planners are signed weekly and used correctly
- To deliver the PSHE curriculum
- To check students have the correct uniform
- To contact parents/carers if necessary



Equipment Needed

It is essential that students come to school prepared to learn:

- Writing pen (and a spare)
- Pencil (and a spare)
- Ruler
- Rubber
- Coloured pencils
- Calculator (scientific)
- School planner (provided by the school)
- A sensible school bag to carry books and equipment



Uniform

We are proud of our uniform and check this regularly, students are expected to have:

- The school blazer
- Black trousers (no skinny/fashion trouser)
- Black pleated skirt – knee length
- White, button collar shirt
- Clip on tie
- Students may wear a plain navy jumper (no cardigans)
- Flat black shoes without logo's
- Natural coloured hair – hair dye must be natural in colour
- No nail polish or acrylic/gel nails (students will be asked to remove them)
- One pair of earrings
- No bracelets, nose studs etc





PE Kit

- Blue rugby shirt
- Black shorts
- Trainers
- Blue football/rugby socks
- Plain white t-shirt for indoor activities
