

Year 12 Internal Examination Policy

Year 12 will sit formal 'mock' examinations on the 19th, 20th, 21st June.

The results of these exams will be treated very seriously when assessing students' capacity to continue with subjects into year 13. There will NOT simply be a free pass into year 13.

Students' consistent effort and commitment to their studies will also be given full consideration when making this decision. For example, a student may achieve an E grade in a mock exam when they should be achieving much more highly. If this is deemed to be due to a lack of effort and commitment, the re-sit must reflect a considerable improvement.

To feel 'comfortable' when approaching year 13, students' should gain at least D grades and above in their mock examinations and overall teacher assessments. However, students' performance will be reviewed on an individual basis

In some instances, students' will re-sit mock exams on 6th, 7th July, where performance has caused a serious cause for concern. This could relate to achievement and/ or effort.

Where there is a cause for concern, final decisions regarding students' formal entry to year 13 will be made from A Level results day on August 17th.

IT IS STRONGLY ADVISED THAT, WHERE APPROPRIATE, A MINORITY OF STUDENTS SHOULD HAVE A PLAN B due to not being able to continue with their studies at Friesland. However, we strongly believe that the vast majority of our students will display the attitude, commitment and ability to approach year 13 with confidence.
