We are forecasting a VA above the line, which is great, as well as an improved academic APS. At this stage last year we were forecasting -0.20 and 34.2 respectively, but achieved -0.08 and 31.0. If we can achieve the same VA improvement in 2019 we will be looking at a very good result indeed.

Vocational VA had been a big strength of the school until 2018, but that cohort was very small (6 entries). It is a concern that from 16 entries the 2019 forecast is at -0.66. Whilst we realise the courses have changed to become more challenging, we need to investigate further how we can improve that number.
