Currently we are revising GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature for the summer 2020 exams.



How your child can develop their learning at home:

- Re-read the set texts or listen to the audio books/plays.
- Learn key quotations for each text. You could even draw images from each text that represent key words/phrases to help you remember key quotations.
- Drawing a timeline of events in the novel or play would also be a useful activity as would a summary of the key idea/meaning in a poem or chapter/scene.
- For the poetry anthology create tables or Venn diagrams to revise.
- Use the knowledge booklets as a revision tool.
- Use online resources such as: BBC Bitesize, Mr Bruff on YouTube and Seneca.
- Have a go at past paper questions (they can ask their English teacher for these) and ask their teacher to look over them
- For English Language, use the Paper 1 and Paper 2 flashcards to help memorise the approach for each question and the question order.
- Learn the 'Upgraded Sentences' for the writing section of the Language Exam.
