

Friesland Y7 Induction Sep 4th 2020



We had to cancel our normal induction process in June due to the school closure and associated restrictions. Below is our plan for a shortened September induction morning for our new Y7.

Start of the day:

Students to arrive at the main entrance to the school, staff will be on hand to escort students to their form groups, lined up on the grass at the front of school. We will use the sports hall if it is raining. As Y7 will be a bubble they will not need to distance, but parents will need to maintain 1m plus distancing on arrival. We ask that parents arrive at school on the left hand side of Nursery Avenue and then leave site by the right hand pavement. We will have staff at the corner to guide parents.

9am: Students arrive and are put into form groups and meet tutor

9:00 – 9:20am: Students spend time in a form room, including a brief remote message from Mr Slaney and Mr Patterson

9:20 – 11:00am: Form activities, including a tour of the school

11:00am: Students are collected from the main gate. Again, we would ask that distancing is observed as you leave the site. We will bring them down form by form: 7F, R, I, E, S, L, A then N. The students will be lined up at the same grass area as they were dropped off in the morning.

During the form activity time we will run through our new 'covid safe' rules on sanitising hands and how their timetable will work.

On Monday 7th September Y7 will again spend the morning with their tutor, as will be the case across all year groups.
