Q. Where can I find a list of uniform/equipment my son/daughter will need?

Q. When will my son/daughter find out which form they're in/who their form tutor is?

A. We will let you know your form before the summer holidays. Details of form tutors will be available on our website shortly – www.frieslandschool.com/year-6

Q. We had a number of questions regarding the transition resources we recently sent home

A. The transition resources we recently sent home are optional to complete. We would strongly recommend the All About Me booklet is completed, as this will give your son/daughter a chance to learn more about their new school, and lets their form tutor get to know your son/daughter a little better. Completed transition resources can be brought in to school in September

Q. Will parents be able to come and visit the school?

A. Of course! As soon as we are able to invite visitors back on to the school site, any parent who would like to come for a visit will be able to

Q. We had a number of questions about support for SEND and other students who may struggle

A. We have excellent teachers who will offer extensive support, as well as a dedicated team of teaching assistants and our SEN team who offer additional support for some students

Q. Will school buses be running in September?

A. Buses will run, but we need detail from government on how they want schools to re-open before we know exactly how they will run. Full detail on transport will follow once we know more. Q. What do we do/where do we go on the first day in September?

A. We will send you details about the plan for the first day of school when we receive updated Government guidance regarding opening in September. We hope to run a day just for new Year 7s on Friday 4th September, but more details will follow shortly

Q. What are the timings for the school day? Do students get any breaks apart from lunchtime?

A. School starts at 8.25am and finishes at 2.40pm. Morning break is from 10.40-10.55 and lunchtime is 11.55am-12.30pm. Please see page 4 of our Prospectus for full timings of the school day:
