



COVID Secure procedures/terms of use

Effective 04/09/2020

We are delighted to be able to welcome you back to Friesland School from 7th September 2020.

We have procedures and requirements in place, in order to keep everyone as safe as possible. Please share this information with all relevant parties. Your staff are responsible to ensuring anyone involved with your follows these procedures.

We take safety of both yourselves, our staff and our students very seriously. We will not hesitate to suspend sessions if we feel hirers are not acting in a COVID Secure manner.

Due to the dynamic nature of being COVID Secure, these procedures may change from time to time. The most up to date version will be posted on our website frieslandschool.com/lettings and will be sent to hirers.

Risk Assessments

All hirers **must** provide a COVID Secure risk assessment before their letting commences.

NHS Test and Trace

We **require** all users to provide us with information for Test and Trace purposes, within 24 hours of each session taking place. The form for submitting Test and Trace information is available at frieslandschool.com/lettings. Failure to provide this information may lead to sessions being suspended.

What is permitted

Football activities are permitted, on both the 3G and the grass pitches, **as long as these are conducted in accordance with current FA/DCMS COVID Secure guidance.**

Wherever possible, please keep 2M distancing from others. Friesland staff are required to maintain 2M distance from others.

Please vacate pitches promptly at the end of sessions, and do not enter pitches until the previous user has vacated.

What is not permitted

Spectators are **prohibited** until further notice. Parents/guardians and other persons will not be able to watch sessions; they must wait in their vehicles, or leave the site and return at the end of the session.

Keeping healthy and safe on site.

Please follow the one way systems on site. These are signposted around the site, a map is also available at the end of this document. Note – these are slightly different to the one way systems that were in place during the summer holidays.

Users are responsible for providing and using their sanitising supplies. We have provided a courtesy hand sanitising station just inside the 3G pitch.

All persons should avoid touching surfaces on site where possible, for example gates, grab rails, etc.

We currently **cannot** provide any access to changing rooms or toilets.

Where you have used Friesland equipment, eg goals, we kindly request that you sanitise any touchpoints at the start and end of your session – this is for the safety of yourself and following users.

Ensure you have your own First Aid supplies, PPE supplies (where relevant), means of contacting emergency services. We cannot provide access to school supplies and equipment.
